

VOCA -NCJA Definition of Equity Across a Continuum "Equity is the intentional practice of change to actualize the fair treatment, advancement, access and opportunity for all to thrive." Equity Across a Continuum refers to the process of embedding equity in the grants administration process from initial concept to final grant reporting. Developing shared language and core practices are integral to the treatment in the treatment action.


