

**Purpose and responsibilities:**

The Senate Judiciary Committee is one of the oldest and most influential standing committees in the U.S. Senate. It is responsible for overseeing the Department of Justice, reviewing federal judicial nominations, and handling legislation related to the federal judiciary, civil liberties, immigration, and criminal law. Its broad legislative jurisdiction has assured its primary role as a forum for the public discussion of social and constitutional issues. The Committee is also responsible for overseeing key executive branch activities and for the initial stages of the confirmation process for all judicial nominations to the federal judiciary.
